

5 Common Objections to Christianity

"You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." — Jeremiah 29:13

1. "Christianity is just blind faith."

Biblical faith is trust based on evidence — the resurrection, fulfilled prophecy, and changed lives — not a leap in the dark (1 Peter 3:15).

2. "The Bible has been changed over time."

The New Testament is supported by thousands of ancient manuscripts, allowing scholars to reconstruct the original text with remarkable confidence.

3. "All religions basically teach the same thing."

Major world religions make contradictory claims about God, salvation, and the afterlife — they can't all be true simultaneously, so the differences matter.

4. "A loving God wouldn't send anyone to hell."

God's love doesn't erase His justice; hell reflects the seriousness of rejecting a holy God, while the cross shows how far He went to avoid it.

5. "Science has disproven God."

Science describes how the universe operates, not why it exists at all — many scientists throughout history and today are also believers who see no conflict.
