

Questions to Ask When Visiting a Church

Questions to keep in mind as you visit churches and look for a place to grow.

- Is the Bible taught faithfully and clearly, not just used as a jumping-off point for other topics?
- Do people seem to genuinely care for one another, not just perform friendliness on Sundays?
- Is there a clear, orthodox statement of what the church believes?
- Are there ways for someone new to get connected — small groups, classes, or a welcome process?
- Does the church emphasize the gospel of grace, or does it feel focused mainly on rules and performance?
- Do the leaders seem accountable to anyone, or is authority concentrated in one person with no oversight?
