

"Who Is Jesus?" One-Pager

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." — John 1:1

Jesus is not just a good teacher or a historical figure — Scripture presents Him as God who became human. Here are the key passages that show who He is.

He is fully God

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:1, 14). Jesus existed before creation and is God Himself, not merely sent by God.

He is the image of the invisible God

"He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For by him all things were created... And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together" (Colossians 1:15-17).

He is God's final and clearest word to us

"Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son... He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature" (Hebrews 1:1-3).

Why it matters

If Jesus is only a wise teacher, His claims to forgive sin and be the only way to God would be arrogant. But if He is who Scripture says — God in human flesh — then His claims deserve serious attention.
